STEREO IMAGES

In these questions of audibility of phase distortion etc. the writers do not consider that a stereo image produced by loudspeakers, or headphones does not behave as the original sound source does. If the listener moves his head to the right the stereo image also moves to the right. In reality the image should appear to move to the left. Surely this effect, which does not occur naturally, can only cause confusion in the direction sensing part of the brain, and blur the image produced.
