
WINDSHIELD-WASHER ALARM

Q. Is there a circuit which will let me know when the windshield washer fluid in my car is running low?

—R. Claudet, Tannersville, NY A. This circuit will do the job. Insert the two metal probes (pin plugs, stiff bare wire, etc.) into the washer fluid



reservoir, leaving tips about 1 inch (2.5 cm) above the bottom. Install indicator *I*1 (which can be a 53 pilot bulb, a Sonalert or a buzzer) at a convenient viewing angle. When the fluid level drops below the probe tips, the lamp will light. Diodes *D*1 and *D*2 can be common 1-A power supply rectifiers. The alarm will work with water and most detergent solutions.
