PIC/AVR Programming Adaptor Board (May-June 2012): since this circuit was designed, Microchip have released a number of new PICs, many of which can be programmed using this board. This includes the PIC16F150x series (four chips). These can be programmed in mode B, not mode C as is implied by Fig.5 on page 78 of the June 2012 issue.

For other new PICs, check the data sheet and compare the programming pin location and supply voltage requirements to that of other micros listed in Fig.5.
