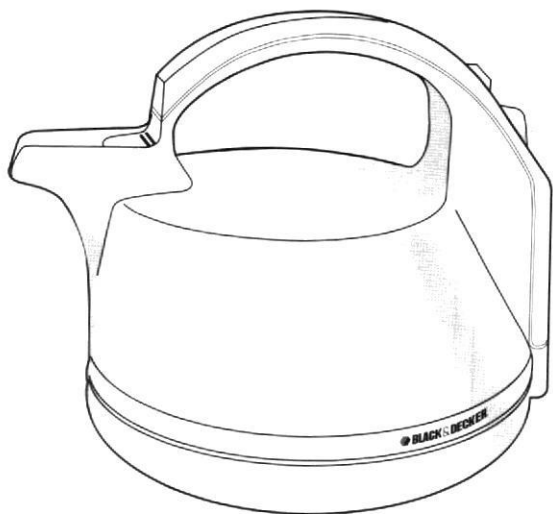

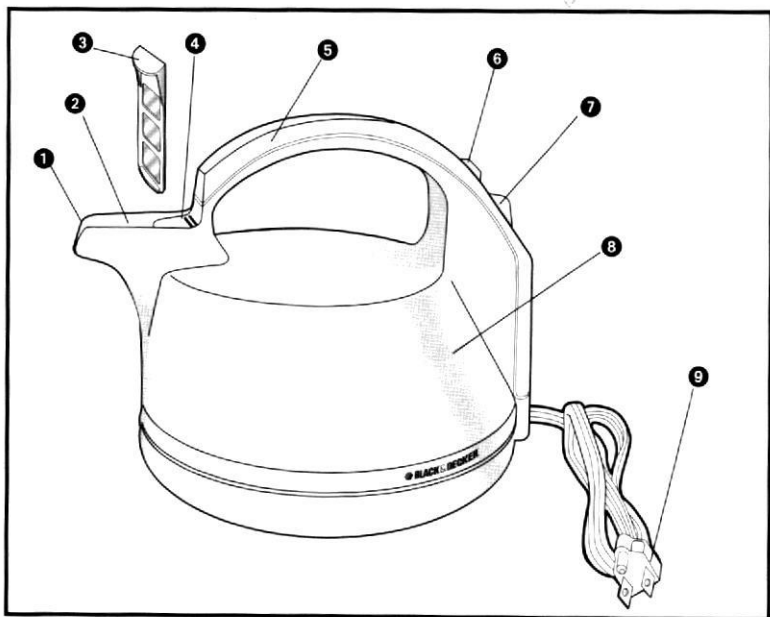

- Do not leave connected to an outlet where room temperature may fall to outdoor winter temperatures. At sub-zero temperatures, the Automatic Control Thermostat may reset and activate the heating element.

SAVE THESE INSTRUCTIONS

ELECTRICAL CORD

The cord length of this appliance was selected to reduce safety hazards that may occur with a longer cord. If more cord length is needed, an extension cord may be used. It should be rated not less than 10 amperes, 120 volts, and should have Underwriters Laboratories or appropriate agency listing. When using a longer cord, be sure to pull on the cord at the plug end, not the appliance end.

GROUNDING PLUG

As a safety feature, this product is equipped with a grounded plug which will only fit into a three-prong outlet. Do not attempt to defeat this safety feature. Improper connection of the grounding conductor may result in the risk of electric shock. Consult a qualified electrician if you are in doubt as to whether the outlet is properly grounded.

How To Use – English

NOTE: Before first use, fill the Kettle with water, plug in and press the Switch to On. Allow to boil. Discard the boiled water.

WARNING: This Kettle is protected by a boil dry safety device. If your Kettle is accidentally left plugged in without being filled or is allowed to boil to a very low level it will automatically repeat a cycle of turning off, cooling down, and coming back on unless unplugged. Unplug the Kettle and wait 5-10 minutes for the heating element to cool down before refilling with cold water and plugging back in for normal use.

BOILING WATER

1. Fill the Kettle to your selected level. Be sure not to exceed the MAX Fill line at the bottom of the Spout to prevent boiling over (A). **NOTE:** The minimum amount of water needed to avoid the safety thermostat cutting off the boiling is 16 oz. (500 ml) equal to 2 standard measuring cups of water.
2. Always use the Kettle on a flat, level surface. Plug in the cord and press On; the Indicator Light will come on.
3. When water has boiled, the light will go out, and the Kettle will shut off automatically. DO NOT attempt to hold the Switch on after boiling to force the Kettle to reheat. Allow to cool and refill with cold water to reuse.
4. DO NOT allow the Kettle to boil dry. Never place fingers, face, etc. near the Vent when boiling (B) as hot steam escapes and could cause scalding.
5. The Kettle has a Cool-Touch Handle and may be moved to a serving table. Be extremely cautious when moving a Kettle with hot water and be sure to place it on heating pad or trivet to protect the table or counter surface.

SCALE FILTER

Always boil water with the Scale Filter in place just behind the spout. Lime scale forms over time when water is heated. Though scale is natural and harmless, it may produce a powdery substance or mineral-like chunks that can get into your hot beverages and affect the taste. The Filter helps prevent particles from pouring into your beverage.

Cleaning

1. Before cleaning, unplug the Kettle and allow to cool completely. Empty any remaining water from the Kettle.
2. Lift the Scale Filter out for cleaning (C). Wash the filter in warm soapy water and rinse or place it in the utensil holder of a dishwasher. Slip it back into the channels just behind the Spout to replace the Filter after cleaning.
3. NEVER IMMERSER THE KETTLE IN WATER OR OTHER LIQUIDS. Do NOT place in a dishwasher.
4. Wipe the exterior of the Kettle with a damp cloth or sponge and dry. Do not use abrasive soaps, cleansers, or scouring pads on any part of the Kettle.

5. Over time, the Kettle may take longer to heat up or may not even boil, depending on your use and the hardness of the water in your area. When this happens, it's time for descaling or removing mineral deposits. For scale, use a scale/lime remover and follow its manufacturer's directions.
6. To remove interior mineral deposits, fill the Kettle with equal parts white vinegar and cold tap water. Do NOT exceed the MAX fill Line. Plug in the Kettle and let boil. Unplug the Kettle and allow it to stand overnight. Empty this mixture and refill with cold tap water. Plug in and boil. Empty the kettle, rinse with cold water, and empty again. You're now ready to use as normal.

4. Limpie el exterior de la tetera y la base con un paño humedecido o con una esponja y séquela bien. No use jabones abrasivos, limpiadores ni almohadillas de fibras abrasivas para limpiar ninguna parte de la tetera.
5. Con el tiempo, la tetera puede calentar el agua pero no hervirla, según el uso y la dureza del agua en área donde usted reside. Cuando esto sucede, llegó la hora de remover las escamas. Use un agente de limpieza para remover escamas/cal conforme las indicaciones del fabricante.
6. Para eliminar los depósitos minerales del interior de la tetera, llénela con partes iguales de agua fría de la llave y vinagre blanco. No exceda el nivel de llenado MAX. Desconecte la tetera y déjela reposar con la mezcla de agua y vinagre de un día para otro. Vacíe la tetera y llénela nuevamente con agua fría. Enchúfela y permita que hierva el agua. Vacía nuevamente la tetera y enjuáguela bien con agua fría para usarla normalmente.

- Do not touch hot surfaces or hot water. Use handle. Care must be taken as burns can occur from touching spilled hot liquids.
- To protect against fire, electric shock or injury, do not place cord, plug, or Kettle in water or other liquid.
- To reduce the risk of fire or electric shock, do not remove bottom cover from base. There are no user-serviceable parts inside. Repair should be done by authorized service personnel only.
- Close supervision is necessary when any appliance is used by or near children.
- Kettle must be operated on a flat surface away from the edge of counter to prevent accidental tipping.
- To protect against electric shock, unplug from outlet when not in use, and before cleaning. To prevent burns, allow to cool before cleaning.
- Do not operate dry. Do not use for other than heating water. Other foods or liquids will contaminate the interior and void the warranty.
- To disconnect, remove plug from outlet. Do not yank on cord as it may damage cord and eventually cause electric shock.
- Do not operate any appliance with a damaged cord or plug or after the appliance malfunctions or is dropped or damaged in any manner. If the product requires attention within the warranty period, call the appropriate toll-free number listed on the cover of this manual for information on examination, repair, or electrical or mechanical adjustment.
- To avoid an electrical overload, do not operate another high-wattage appliance on the same circuit.
- The use of an accessory attachment not approved by the manufacturer may result in fire, electric shock or injury.
- Do not use outdoors.
- Do not let cord hang over edge of table or counter or touch hot surfaces.
- In models that contain filters: To avoid scalding, be sure the Filter is fully inserted into the Kettle Spout before plugging in the Kettle. Do not attempt to remove the Filter during the boiling cycle. Unplug and allow the Kettle to cool before removing the filter for cleaning.
- Do not place on or near a hot gas or electric burner or in a microwave or heated oven.
- To avoid possible steam damage, turn spout away from walls or cabinets during use; use a pad under the Kettle to prevent damage to surfaces.

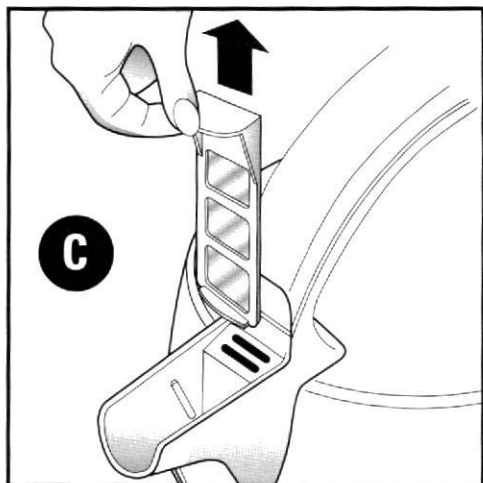
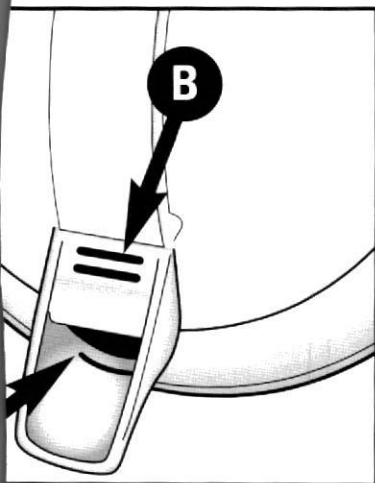

- En los modelos con filtros: Para evitar quemaduras, asegúrese que el filtro esté introducido de lleno dentro de la boquilla de la tetera antes de conectarla. No procure retirar el filtro mientras hierve el agua. Desconecte la tetera y permita que se enfríe por completo antes de retirar el filtro para lavarlo.
- No coloque la tetera sobre ni cerca de una hornilla de gas o eléctrica ni dentro de un horno caliente ni uno de microondas.
- Con el fin de evitar cualquier daño a consecuencia de la emisión de vapor, cuando use la tetera aleje la boquilla de las paredes y de los gabinetes; coloque la tetera sobre una almohadilla protectora para evitar daños a las superficies.
- A fin de evitar las quemaduras y el riesgo de lesiones personales, tome mucha precaución cuando lleve la tetera llena de agua caliente de un lugar a otro.
- No deje la tetera conectada a una toma de corriente en donde la temperatura ambiental baje a 0°F o menos ya que el termostato de control automático puede reactivar la resistencia de calor.
- Este producto ha sido diseñado solamente para uso doméstico. Al usarse con cualquier otro fin la garantía perderá su validez de inmediato.

GUARDE ESTAS INSTRUCCIONES

EL CABLE ELECTRICO

El cable de esta unidad fue seleccionado a fin de evitar la posibilidad de que alguien se enrede o se tropiece en uno más largo. De ser necesaria una extensión, use una calificada para no menos de 10 amperes, 120 volts e inscrita por UL (Underwriters Laboratories) o una agencia apropiada. Cuando use un cable de extensión, no permita que cuelgue sobre el área de trabajo para evitar que alguien se tropiece en ella accidentalmente.

ENCHUFE DE TIERRA

Como medida de seguridad esta unidad tiene un enchufe de puesta a tierra que únicamente puede enchufarse a una toma de tres contactos. Por ningún punto trate
