
LOW-FREQUENCY FILTER

Thank you for the good job on my article about the low-frequency filter kit (**Radio-Electronics**, November 1981). There are two errors that your readers should know about, however. In the schematic of Figure 7, the connection to pin "H" of the filter kernel ($-V_B$) should come from the other side of C16. Figure 3, showing the input and output noise of the low-frequency filter, is labeled as a spectrum analysis; though it was taken from a spectrum analyzer, those are time waveforms, not spectra.

Fortunately, neither error will affect anyone's building and installing the LFF from the layout, component locators, and interconnection drawings, all of which are error-free.

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
