

TO TEST THE HOOK UP:

Call the line with the modem. It should answer with a continuous 1 KHz tone. The tone will cease and the modem will hang up in about 30 seconds. If you have a remote terminal or a computer with a terminal program, you can call up the TC4 and try some of the monitor commands described in the TC4 manual.

NOTES:

- 1. Systems before 1987 did not have printed circuit connections from serial port on CPU to MIO 66 -72. For these systems, run wires from MIO to CPU "IN" and "OUT," and connect MIO B:68 and B:70 to MIO "Z" (OV). Avoid connecting modem common directly to CPU common.
- 2. To get communication, the output from one device (modem) must be connected to the input of the other (TC4 CPU). Communication "ear to ear" and "mouth to mouth" won't work.
- 3. Consult modem manual if necessary to defeat internal "handshake lines."
