

2A, and as an inverter, Fig. 2B. Neither design requires external resistors nor capacitors, and both can be operated on standard 5-volt dc power sources. In addition to serving as a CMOS/TTL interface, the 555 can be used as an interface driver between CMOS logic and relays, etc.

Ted Reiter (1442 Brook Drive, Titusville, FL 32780) suggests that the ubiquitous 555 timer can be used effectively as a CMOS-logic-to-TTL interface device. Given in Fig. 2, his circuits illustrate the use of the 555 as a CMOS/TTL buffer, Fig.
