# **USING BASIC FUNCTIONS**

If your system does not use the standard numbering plan, certain feature access codesmay be different than described. Check with your communications manager.

#### **OUTSIDE CALLS**

Placing a call:

- Lift handset and press Line key.
  You may also be able to press ICM and dial a line code (9, 90-98) or a line number (801-816).
- Dial telephone number.

Answering a call:

- Lift handset.
- If you are not connected, press flashing Line key.

Answering a call ringing over paging speakers:

- Lift handset.
- Press ICM and dial \*, 0.

#### INTERCOM CALLS

**Calling** another extension (also see Direct Station Selection):

- Lift handset and press ICM.

  To have your call ring the other extension, dial I before the next step.
- Dial extension number.

If you hear two beeps, you can speak right away--your voice is broadcast over the other extension's speaker.

Answering a ringing call (ICM key flashes):

- Answering a call announced over your speaker:
  - HOLD

Placing a call on Hold:

Retrieving a held outside call:

- Lift handset or press flashing ICM key.
- Speak toward the phone or lift handset for privacy.
- Press HOLD and hang up.

Press HOLD twice for Exclusive Hold.

*If* the Ike appears on your phone:

Lift handset and press flashing Line key.

If the line does not appear on your phone:

Lift handset and press flashing HOLD.

## HOLD (continued)

Retrieving a held Intercom

- Lift handset.
- Press KM.
- Press HOLD.

#### TRANSFER

Transferring an outside call (also see Direct Station Selection):

Retrieving a transferred call:

- Press ICM.
- Dial extension number.

  Announce call if you wish.
  - Hang up.
  - Lift handset.
  - Press flashing Line key for call.

#### **CONFERENCE**

Setting up a three-way conversation:

- Establish an outside or Intercom call.
- Press CONF.
- Establish next call.
- Press CONF.

# RESPONDING TO SIGNAL TONES

Two tones during handset call:

After the tones, you hear a co-worker's **voic** over your **conversation**.

To reply, press and hold MIC/DND.

To talk to the first caller, release

MIC/DND.

One tone during speakerphone

call:

Fast busy or warble tone anytime:

This means a call is waiting to be answered.

- Press HOLD.
- Press flashing **ICM** or Line key.

This means you made a mistake in-placing & call or using a feature.

Hang up and start over.

## HAVING YOUR MESSAGE GO THROUGH

#### OFF-HOOK SIGNALING

**Sending** a signal to a busy extension:

## M ESSAGE WAITING

Leaving a Message Waiting indication (flashing MSG key):

Swing the name or extension number that left a Message:

Responding to a flashing MSG key at your phone:

#### CALLBACK

(For extensions and lines)

Having the system call you whrn a busy extension or line becomes free:

Answering when the system rings your phone:

Dial 1 when you hear ring-busy tone.

If you hear two beeps, you can speak

If you hear ringing, wait for an answer.

- Place an Intercom call to an extension.

  Receive busytone or no-answer.
- Press MSG and hang up.
- Do not lift handset.
- Press MSG.

You see: MSG FROM in the display. Repeatedly press MSG to see all messages. Stop at the extension you wish to call.

- Lift handset.
- Press MSG

You are connected to the extension that left the Message. If MSG key continues to flash, more messages are waiting.

■ Call the busy extension or press the busy Line key.

You can also use this procedure if you dial a line code and receive busy tone.

- Dial C.
- Hang up.

You know it's the system calling you because you hear a series of long rings.

Lift handset.

The system connects you to previously busy extension or line.

#### PAGE

Using page zone codes:

Lift handset.

Press ICM.

■ Dial page zone number (1 to 8).

■ Dial \*

Make 'announcement.

■ Hang up.

#### PARK/PAGE

Parking a call so it can be answered from any phone:

Press ICM.

Dial Park Orbit code (60-69) or \* + ext.

Dial page zone number (1 to 8).

Dial \*.

■ Make announcement.

■ Hang up.

Picking up a parked call:

Lift handset.

Press ICM.

■ Dial Park Orbit code (60-69) or • + ext.

## CALL FORWARDING

Rerouting your incoming calls to another extension:

■ Press ICM.

Press PGM#.

Dial extension number to receive calls.

Do one of the following:

Dial 1 to forward calls not answered.
Dial 2 to forward calls nor answered
or when busy.

Dial 3 to forward all calls.

You hear dial tone.

Press HF to hang up.

Your MSG key flashes.

Canceling your Call Forwarding:

- Press KM.
- Press PGM#.
- Press HF to hang up.

ASSIGNMENT

PRIME LINE

Enabling RA or NR disables DRA and **vice** versa. To **disable** ringing. disable NR.RA and DRA.

Cut on dotted line and insert into Directory Tray under phone.

#### **USER-PROGRAMMABLE FEATURES**

To program a feature, press PGM# and dial the feature's code. For example, to se! Nigh1 Ring, press PGM# and dii NR. Tha remaining slaps vary with each feature.


## PLACING YOUR CALLS QUICKLY

Your access level determines the features you can program. See your communications manager.

Enabling RA or NR disables DRA and vice versa. To disable ringing, disable NR, RA and DRA.

Cut on dotted line and insert into Directory Tray under phone.

#### REDIAL

Redialing the last outside number you called:

- Lift handset.
- Press DIAL.
- Press LAST.

If you hear busy lone right away, you must manually select an idle line before pressing DIAL.

#### SAVE

Saving a number to be dialed later:

Calling a saved number:

- Press DIAL after dialing your number.
- Press SAVE.
- Lift handset.
- Press DIAL.
- Press SAVE.

If you hear busy tone right away, you must manually select an idle line before pressing DIAL.

#### DIRECT STATION SELECTION

Assigning a DSS key to an extension:

Calling an extension using a DSS key:

Transferring an outside call using a DSS key:

#### SPEED DIAL

Storing a telephone number for Personal Speed Dial: Press **KM**.

Press PGM#.

Press desired DSS key (1-15) and dial extension number.

> To program more keys, repeat from: "Press PGM#".

Press HF.

■ Lift handset and press ICM. If a DSS key lights, the extension is busy or in DND.

■ Press DSS key for desired extension.

Press ICM and DSS key for extension. Announce call if you wish.

■ Hang up.

■ Press DIAL, PGM#.

■ Press Personal Speed Dial key (1-15).

OR Dial Speed Dial bin (20-29, 50-50). A Display phone may ask you to assign

a name. To skip this step, dial N. To enter a name, see the instructions in your Administrative Guide.

■ Press a Line key (or ICM to store an Intercom feature).

You may also be able to store a line group by dialing a code (9, 90-98).

■ Dial telephone number to be stored. To enter a pause, press HOLD. For example, to have your system dial 9, pause and then dial 888-8000, enter: 9 (HOLD) 888-8000.

Press HF.

#### SPEED DIAL (continued)

Calling a Personal or System **Speed Dial number:** 

■ Lift handset

You can preselect a line by pressing a line key. If you preselect, you must press ICM instead of DIAL before dialing a bin number.

■ Press **DIAL**.

Press Personal Speed Dial key (1-15).

Dial the Speed Dial bin (20-29, 50-59). If you stored a pause, the dialing may stop. Dial \* to restart dialing. Your System bins are normally 700-799.
