

INSTALLATION IN RUCTIONS

The one-time installation procedure consists of the main installation plus five sections. Any keystrokes you need to input are printed in **bold lettering**.

Make sure not to have a write-protect tab on your BOOK-MARK diskette during installation and de-installation.

- Boot your system from the hard disk in the normal manner
- Insert the BOOKMARK floppy disk in Drive A.
- At the C> prompt, type A:LOADMARK and press Enter.

Select one of the following:

- I Install BOOKMARK on a hard disk
- D De-install BOOKMARK from a hard disk
- C Change Settings

Notes on Main Installation Menu:

- I Installs BOOKMARK on a hard disk from the floppy.
- De-installs BOOKMARK from a hard disk to the original BOOKMARK floppy diskette.
- C Change Settings. Allows you to change your BOOKMARK Placement Intervals, BOOKMARK Function Key Assignment, backup option, and password implementation.
- If I is chosen, proceed directly to SECTION ONE.
- If C is chosen, proceed directly to SECTION ONE.

 If D (<u>De-install BOOKMARK from a hard disk</u>) is chosen, place the original BOOKMARK diskette in drive A:. You will be presented with the following screen:

Is this correct y/n?

Drive C: and the root directory (\setminus) are Default. Press **Enter** after each to accept these defaults. If you had not accepted these defaults during the initial installation, type in the selections you made, followed by the **Enter** Key.

Press y to confirm or n to go over these choices.

Caution: De-installation of BOOKMARK from your system requires the original BOOKMARK diskette in Drive A:. BOOKMARK should be de-installed if: Hard disk is reformatted; Hard disk is repartitioned; or if Dealer servicing is required.

Notes on defining the hard disk usage:

- If you have one hard disk drive, BOOKMARK will automatically select the C: drive. Press Enter.
- If you have two hard disk drives, then you must type C: or D:. Press Enter.
- If the root directory (\) is to be used press Enter. If not, type in the subdirectory name.

If you receive an invalid directory message, please enter a valid directory name.

 You may now select a Single or Double BOOKMARK backup by selecting S for a single backup file, or D for double backup files.

The BOOKMARK double backup file system provides a fail-safe way of preventing data loss in case of power outage during a BOOKMARK placement. BOOKMARK alternates writing to the files so if one file is damaged by being written during a power outage, the other previously written file will be intact. The maximum data loss occurring in this incident will be two BOOKMARK placement intervals. Each BOOKMARK backup file occupies the same amount of space on your hard disk system as exists in your system's RAM (512k on a 512k RAM system, 640k on a 640k system, etc.), plus up to 256k of video RAM. The two-file BOOKMARK system is recommended for hard disk systems of 20 Megabytes or greater.

Press y to confirm your selections or n to go back and correct them.

Notes on selecting the BOOKMARK Function Keys:

- After 'BOOKMARK on/off toggle:' Press Key Combination. (e.g. Right Shift F9)
- After 'BOOKMARK key:' Press Key Combination. (e.g. Right Shift F10)
- Press y for BOOKMARK's Extended Key Buffer, or n for no Extended Key Buffer.

If you are satisfied with your choices press **y**, if you want to go back and change them press **n**.

BOOKMARK Toggle On/Off Key allows you to enable or disable BOOKMARK at any time, within a program. In all text modes a message with BOOKMARK's on/off status appears on the upper right-hand corner of the display.

This status message disappears when scrolled off the screen or when other text or graphics overwrites that area of the display. From DOS (C>) the status message can be cleared from the screen with the clear screen DOS command (C>CLS).

BOOKMARK Key places an immediate BOOKMARK without waiting for the next BOOKMARK interval to occur, resets the BOOKMARK placement interval counter, and displays the 'BOOKMARK placement in Progress' message in the upper right-hand corner of the display momentarily in all text modes. (See USING BOOKMARK on Page 9.)

You may choose any key or combination of keys, keeping in mind which ones you use with other software so as to prevent any possible conflict. We suggest those of you with newer keyboards select the F11 and F12 keys.

When the selected BOOKMARK Function Keys are identical to those of other software currently in use, the BOOKMARK function will execute first and then the function associated with the other software will execute.

The Extended Key Buffer stores up to 127 characters during BOOKMARK placements. When the Extended Key Buffer is not implemented, the normal 15-character key buffer provided by your PC remains. If you use other RAM-resident software or an IBM-compatible computer system, please see TECHNICAL CONSIDERATIONS Pages 12 & 13. Please proceed to SECTION FIVE.

Notes on Password Protection:

- Press N if no Password Protection is desired.
- Press P for Password Protection.

Password Protection prevents your work in progress from being resumed by unauthorized persons.

If Password Protection is desired, only one user will have control over BOOKMARK. The first person attempting to use BOOKMARK will be asked for a password. A maximum six-character alpha/numeric must be entered. All characters will be recognized as upper case. This password must be given after each subsequent attempt to resume. Should another individual attempt to resume work with-

out a password, they will be blocked from using BOOKMARK and returned directly to DOS. At the Resume y/n prompt, the other individual may answer **n** and BOOKMARK will go into DOS (C>). Work on any application may be done, but will not be protected by BOOKMARK.

Relinquishing the Password. The password holder may relinquish the password (and control of BOOKMARK) when through with their application. Return to DOS (C>) and type BOOKMARK DELETE. Only the password holder will be able to use the BOOKMARK DELETE command. The next time the computer is booted a new password may be chosen after the Resume y/n prompt.

Forgotten Password or to Change Password. If the password is forgotten or a password change is desired, follow the INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS starting on Page 2 and select C to Change Settings. The Password-Protected data in the BOOKMARK back-up file(s) will be inaccessible, then overwritten during the next BOOKMARK placement.

- Remove the BOOKMARK diskette and press any key (resets PC).
- Once your system reboots, BOOKMARK will run for about a minute and write the reserved and hidden file(s) to the hard disk. You may then begin normal operations. BOOKMARK is now functioning. Please refer to USING BOOKMARK. (Caution: If the hard disk does not have enough room to install BOOKMARK, a message will appear. You will have to make space available.)

Notes on the Completed Installation:

- BOOKMARK has also created or appended your AUTOEXEC.BAT file automatically.
- BOOKMARK has placed itself first except for date, time, and AST clock.

 BOOKMARK has been written to the chosen directory and BOOKMARK has also created or appended your CONFIG.SYS file with the KEYBUF.SYS device driver if you have chosen implementation of the Extended Key Buffer. This driver must always be first in the CON-FIG.SYS file. If you use other RAM-resident software, RAM Disks, or an IBM-compatible computer please see TECHNICAL CONSIDERATIONS Pages 12 & 13.

BOOKMARK will operate for a single user on a single computer.

Options:

Any software loaded on the fixed disk such as:

- Accounting Systems (Must use BOOKMARK CON-SOLE command. See Page 11.)
- Databases (Must use BOOKMARK CONSOLE command. See Page 11.)
- DOS Operations—Hard Disk Backup, Mag Tape Backup, Disk to Disk Copy.
- RAM Disks, Expanded Memory—BOOKMARK automatically places itself first in the AUTOEXEC.BAT file.
 (You should load Expanded Memory or RAM Disks first. See TECHNICAL CONSIDERATIONS Pages 12 & 13.)
- RAM-resident software—See TECHNICAL CON-SIDERATIONS Pages 12 & 13.
- Spreadsheets
- Word Processors



From now on, your system will boot to the question:*

C>BOOKMARK

Resume, y/n?

- If you press y, you can resume where you left off. The message 'Resuming from last BOOKMARK placement. .' will appear and within 4 to 8 seconds the restoration will be complete. The length of time required to restore is dependent on your processor and hard disk drive access speeds.
- If you press n, you will be at the C> prompt.
- If Password Protection is activated, BOOKMARK will ask for the password after y to resume has been pressed.
- The BOOKMARK toggle on/off status will appear in the upper right-hand corner of the display. It will read 'BOOKMARK toggle ON' to remind you that BOOK-MARK is enabled by default.

As you operate your PC with BOOKMARK running behind other application software, the message 'BOOKMARK Placement in Progress' will appear in the upper right-hand corner of the screen. The message will appear at your designated time/keystroke intervals for 4 to 8 seconds (the same amount of time as noted above for restoration). Keyboard input is unseen during this time but buffered up to 127 characters if use of the Extended Key Buffer has been implemented, otherwise the key buffer is 15 characters. These buffered characters

will appear on the screen after the placement message disappears.

The BOOKMARK Toggle On/Off Key is for turning BOOKMARK on or off within a program. This is used to prevent BOOKMARK placement(s), if desired.

THE BOOKMARK Key is used to force a BOOKMARK placement at any given time without waiting for the next minute or keystroke interval to arrive. When in DOS and in certain application programs, you must press the **Enter** key after pressing the **BOOKMARK Key**.

BOOKMARK operates automatically while you work. There is no need to invoke BOOKMARK manually unless desired.

Change All Settings:

- Place your BOOKMARK diskette in Floppy Drive A:
- At the C> prompt type A: LOADMARK
- · Select C for Change Settings

Refer to MAIN INSTALLATION MENU, Page 2 and continue through the installation procedure selecting your new settings as desired.

Change Settings for BOOKMARK Placement intervals only:

 From DOS, type BOOKMARK Mx Ky ON, replacing the x with the desired number of minutes, and y with the desired number of keystrokes. See BOOKMARK COMMANDS FROM DOS Page 11.

*If BOOKMARK is not desired in the AUTOEXEC.BAT file, it may be deleted using any DOS Utility.

APPLIENS AND SUC

Auto-Resume Function: Any application which sorts, prints, or must operate overnight can be automatically resumed after a power failure without user intervention. Useful for backing up the hard disk while unattended. Place the BOOKMARK AUTO command in the AUTOEXEC.BAT file. If the power fails during the night, BOOKMARK will allow the backup to be completed upon return of power without your attendance.

Automated Save, Exit and Resume: Press the BOOK-MARK Key to place a manual BOOKMARK. Wait for the BOOKMARK placement to be completed. Power down. When you're ready to work again simply power up and respond y to resume y/n.

Automated Save and Resume: Press the **BOOKMARK Key**.

Computer Novices: Place a BOOKMARK in the application and file screen to be worked on. Power down. Have the novice power up and press y to resume and start work. When work is completed, have them press the BOOKMARK Key, wait for the BOOKMARK placement to be completed, and power down. This is easier for most novices than navigating through menus.

<u>Disk Full Protection:</u> Should you fill all the space on your hard disk, a Disk Full message appears when you try to save what is in RAM. To prevent the loss of data in RAM,

press the **BOOKMARK Key** to place a BOOKMARK at that point. When the BOOKMARK placement is complete, power down and reboot. Press **n** to resume. Turn off BOOKMARK with the **toggle on/off key**. Remove unwanted files from the hard disk to free up space. Type **BOOKMARK AUTO**.

<u>Frozen Keyboard:</u> If your system keyboard ceases to respond for any reason, power down, wait ten seconds and power up. After the system boots, press **y** to resume. Within seconds you will be back to the last BOOKMARK placement.

Go Back to the Last BOOKMARK: Reset your PC, then answer **y** to resume.

System Crash: After reboot you can resume from the last BOOKMARK placement by answering **y** to the Resume y/n question.

<u>UNDO Function:</u> Reboot your PC and press **y** to resume. Work done since the last BOOKMARK placement is deleted.

Experiment, then UNDO: Press the BOOKMARK Key. Disable BOOKMARK by pressing the BOOKMARK toggle on/off key. Experiment with your data. When you're done experimenting, exit the application to DOS (C>). Type BOOKMARK AUTO. You will be returned to the BOOKMARK you placed prior to experimentation.

B=OK =RK C= NDS FR D=S

BOOKMARK HELP—Displays the following DOS command summary:

BOOKMARK—Placed in AUTOEXEC.BAT file during LOADMARK. This means that your computer now boots up to the **Resume y/n** question.

BOOKMARK AUTO – Resumes where you left off automatically, without you having to type **y** to resume.

BOOKMARK CONSOLE—Invokes BOOKMARK before Console I/O and not during Disk I/O. This insures that the Read-Modify-Write cycle of a program has been completed prior to BOOKMARK placement. Use in batch file activation of data base and accounting systems programs.

BOOKMARK DELETE—Deactivates BOOKMARK and deletes BOOKMARK backup files, which can be recreated by BOOKMARK ON. This is *not* the same as the choice 'D' to De-install BOOKMARK from a hard disk in the installation menu. Also used to relinquish password.

BOOKMARK OFF—Deactivates BOOKMARK from DOS, the last capture is maintained.

BOOKMARK ON—Activates BOOKMARK from DOS, without resuming from the last BOOKMARK.

BOOKMARK SHOW—Displays the current BOOK-MARK settings.

BOOKMARK M5 ON – Places a BOOKMARK every 5 minutes.

BOOKMARK M5 K500 ON—Places a BOOKMARK every 5 minutes or 500 keystrokes, whichever comes first.

The letters 'M' and 'K' followed by a digit (or digits), a space, and the letters ON can be used on the BOOKMARK command line to override the current installation settings.

BOOKMARK in Batch Files:

You may wish to have specific BOOKMARK placement intervals for different types of programs. To do this, create or append the batch files associated with those programs by using the above command string (i.e. BOOKMARK M5 ON). Consult your DOS Manual for more information on DOS Commands and batch files.

TECHNICAL CONSIDERATIONS

APPLICATION RESTORED BUT RUNNING SLOW

Some BASIC programs (e.g. games) that are BOOK-MARKed in the middle of a PLAY statement may resume at a slow speed. Try exiting the application, then re-entering it. This should cause the timer to be restored to the rate specific to the application, not to timer default rate.

CLOCK CARDS

In batch files, the BOOKMARK Command must be placed after the clock activation command including DOS Commands for time and date, or ASTCLOCK/R.

DEVELOPER'S AID

By placing BOOKMARK during a failure, the same failure will be resumed and can be analyzed for cause.

DIFFICULTY RESTORING PROGRAM OR VIDEO UNCLEAR

The program appears to function properly except for the video display. Allow the application program to update the screen (e.g. page down, then page up to refresh video). These symptoms usually appear due to the use of a non-compatible video adapter, or one that does not accurately emulate the IBM design standards.

DISPLAYS

BOOKMARK does not support more than one display per system.

HARD DISK OPTIMIZATION

Use the **BOOKMARK DELETE** command from DOS

before optimizing or compacting data on the hard disk. When compacting of data is complete, type **BOOKMARK** from the C>.

LOADMARK NOTES

The use of the DOS commands ASSIGN, JOIN, and SUBST is not supported and should not be used with BOOKMARK.

MODEMS

BOOKMARK allows externally or battery-powered modems that have carrier tone present during a PC crash or keyboard freeze to resume the communications session by resetting and pressing **y** to resume. The BOOKMARK resume is not always possible once carrier tone has been lost.

OTHER DRIVES

If a floppy drive or tape backup was in use during the previous BOOKMARK placement, then the same floppy disk or tape cartridge must be present during the 'BOOKMARK resume y/n' sequence.

RAM DISKS

VDISK.SYS installed in the CONFIG. SYS within the base 640k RAM is restored by BOOKMARK. Memory over 640k is not supported. It is therefore recommended that implementation of expanded RAM Disk commands be located first in the AUTOEXEC.BAT file. BOOKMARK will recognize files located in those areas during the restore process, but will not restore that area.

RAM-RESIDENT SOFTWARE

System crashes may be caused by a conflict between the KEYBUF.SYS driver and certain RAM-resident software. Try installing BOOKMARK without the Extended Key Buffer if you have it implemented. IBM-compatibles may also have conflict with KEYBUF.SYS and should be installed without the Extended Key Buffer.

RESET (CTRL, ALT, DEL simultaneously) WITH HERCULES PLUS INSTALLED

Will result in an inverse pattern on the screen. This is restorable by pressing **y** to resume (even though you won't see the question: BOOKMARK Resume y/n?). BOOKMARK will resume without forcing *Hercules Plus* owners to power down.

UNSUCCESSFUL BOOKMARK PLACEMENT

This can be caused by a power failure during a BOOK-MARK Placement. By using the Double Backup option in Installation, work in progress can be resumed from the previous BOOKMARK Backup Placement.

In the Hercules Monochrome Graphics mode, a timing error causes the inaccurate BOOKMARK Placement. If you notice a scrambled dot pattern in the upper right-hand corner of the screen where the 'BOOKMARK Placement in Progress' message ususally appears, press the BOOKMARK Placement Function Key to place another BOOKMARK.

BOK ARK ERROR ESSAGES

Problem	Solution

CAN'T ACCESS BOOKMARK BACKUP FILE(S)

Damaged BOOKMARK files due to internal system DOS error.

CAN'T ACCESS BOOKMARK CONFIGURATION FILE

 Your configuration of BOOKMARK as selected in the install procedure has been lost or damaged.

CAN'T ACCESS DIRECTORY C:\

· An internal DOS error.

CAN'T CREATE BOOKMARK BACKUP FILE(S)

· Not enough free space on the hard disk.

CAN'T FIND DOS PARTITION

 BOOKMARK cannot locate the reserved area of the hard disk where the BOOKMARK Backup files are stored.

CAN'T READ CURRENT DIRECTORY

· The current directory has become invalid.

Re-install BOOKMARK. See Page 2.

- Reconfigure your BOOKMARK settings by using the Change Setting option in MAIN INSTALLATION MENU. See Page 2.
- Reboot system. If reboot is unsuccessful, then hard disk may need reformatting or Dealer Service. Consult DOS Reference Manual.
- Make room. Delete files or back up files to a floppy, mag tape, etc.
- Repartition and reformat the hard disk. See your DOS manual. Be sure to de-install BOOKMARK first. See Page 2.

 Reboot system. If reboot is unsuccessful, then hard disk may need reformatting or Dealer Service. Consult DOS Reference Manual.

Problem _

INSUFFICIENT MEMORY

 After typing BOOKMARK AUTO (from DOS), there is not room in RAM for the BOOKMARK backup file to be restored.

DISK I/O ERROR

 Due to an internal system DOS error, BOOKMARK is unable to read or write the Backup Files.
