
Checking on the Energy Crisis

Q. With the utilities cutting their power due to the energy crisis, I keep wondering just what my line voltage is. However, my VOM is needed for other purposes—besides it is difficult to read minor changes in the power-line voltage. What would you suggest?



A. Try the 115-to-125-volt power line monitor shown above. Calibration is performed by using an accurate ac meter. The scale on the 1-mA meter can be redrawn to fit. Any type of silicon rectifier diode can be used in the bridge.
