



### AS A WORK TABLE

Your Hand Truck can be used as a portable work table. Use a ¼" to ¾" piece of plywood for the top (Å). Put top on metal hoop, and draw a line around outside edge (B), to measure size of board.






Cut out board and set on hoop and draw line around inside edge of hoop (C). Nail on small wooden stopper pieces to fit inside of hoop (D), to hold board in place. Cut out small notches where pins on handle hold the hoop in upright position (E).




### To Transport Or Store Outboard Motors

Use the Hand Truck to transport or store small outboard motors. Attach a  $2 \times 4$  piece of wood (at least as wide as the handle, or wider), just below bend in the handles (Å).




## There are at least 2 ways to do it:


l. Drill a 21/32" hole through the wood and through both sides of the handle (B). Install %" cap screws, with washers, through wood and handle. Install lock washer and hex nut on cap screw (C).



2. You can use u-bolts to hold 2 x 4 to handle and avoid the need for a hole drilled in the handle. Use a u-bolt (D) with slightly wider inside diameter than handle. Mark position and drill 2 holes on each side of board (E), hole diameter should be slightly larger than diameter of u-bolt. Insert u-bolt and secure with large washer, lock washer and hex nut on each end (F).



The Hand Truck is shipped unassembled. To assemble, attach casters (A) to base, using washers and nuts supplied. Insert axle (B) through U-shaped brackets, install washer, pre-grease axle then slide on wheel, then washer and insert cotter pin (C) and spread. Attach toe plate (D) into proper position, using screws and nuts. For upright use, insert handle so it fits as shown (E), line-up holes and insert hitch pin clips (F).



To use Hand Truck as a dolly in the horizontal position, remove handle and lay hand truck down on caster wheels and reverse toe plate for base support (G). You can use it as a horizontal hand cart (H) by inserting the handles into holders (I) and inserting hitch pin clips (J).




# And there are other ways to use your Hand Truck & Dolly


## TO HOLD LAWN & TRASH BAGS

To use Hand Truck to support trash or lawn bag, pull hoop (A) up to horizontal position and push toward cart, locking it under studs (B).






To hang lawn bag, first fasten elastic strap to hoop (C)... to do this, put ends of strap through outside slots (D), pinch together and push both ends back through middle slot (E), hang bag over hoop, secure with elastic strap (F). If strap won't hold, tie a knot using the two ends.



For added stability, use a small weight placed on toe plate (G). This will help prevent Hand Truck from tipping over if top-heavy or on an incline.

## **AS A YARD & GARDEN CART**

You can use the Hand Truck & Dolly as a helper for all types of outdoor work. You can use an empty 24 bottle pop-case (A) to hold brooms, rakes, hoes and





You can use a box 15" x 24" (B) and use the Hand Truck in the vertical or horizontal position, for all types of yard and garden work.

You can even put the hoop in the upright position and use the work top (C . . . see back side for how to make work top) and you have an extra work shelf, to hold tools and other supplies.
